## MUNICIPAL IMPACT OF THE GOVERNOR'S PROPOSED STATE BUDGET: SPECIAL APPROPRIATIONS FORUM WITH MUNICIPAL LEADERS

Municipal leaders will discuss the impact of the Governor's proposed state budget on towns and cities before a special forum of the General Assembly's Appropriations Committee on Friday, March 15, from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. in the State Legislative Office Building, Room 2C.

These municipal CEOs will continue to push for the General Assembly to reject:

- The unprecedented changes in the structure of state grants and payments-in-lieu-of-taxes reimbursements to cities and towns, as presented in the Governor's proposed budget.
- Towns and cities losing \$128 million in state aid that helps fund non-education operating expenses. State aid has been diverted to education and capital programs.
- The proposed elimination of the property tax on motor vehicles, without providing state funding reimbursement to municipalities that would result in at least a \$633 million loss in local revenues annually.

Cities and towns are asking the General Assembly for help. Let's work together to develop a state budget that protects municipal revenues, residential and business property taxpayers, and the quality of life in Hometown Connecticut.
