Statement of the Connecticut Conference of Municipalities (CCM) Concerning Governor Malloy's Energy Strategy

James J. Finley, Executive Director and CEO of the Connecticut Conference of Municipalities (CCM), issued the following statement on the energy strategy unveiled earlier today (Friday, Oct. 5) by Governor Malloy.
