CCM to co-host gubernatorial debate with AARP Connecticut and CT Mirror

The Connecticut Conference of Municipalities (CCM), along with AARP Connecticut and The Connecticut Mirror, will host a 2014 Connecticut Gubernatorial Candidate Debate tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, Sept. 23, at Hamden Middle School.

The debate will begin at 7 p.m. and be moderated by Mirror Capitol Bureau Chief Mark Pazniokas. The event will be streamed live on ctmirror.org.

CCM is Connecticut's statewide association of towns and cities. It is a nonpartisan, inclusionary organization that celebrates the commonalities between, and champions the interests of, urban, suburban and rural communities. CCM represents 155 of our 169 municipalities, where 93 percent of the state's population lives.
